

Johanna Bond is the Sydney and Frances Lewis Professor of Law at Washington and Lee University School of Law. An expert in international human rights law and gender and the law, Bond joined the W&L law faculty in 2008. Her forthcoming book, *Global Intersectionality and Contemporary Human Rights*, will be published by Oxford University Press in 2021. Bond's scholarship has appeared in the *Southern California Law Review*, the *Emory Law Journal*, the *Columbia Journal of Gender and Law*, the *Yale Human Rights and Devehe* (Carolina Academic Press, 2005).
